

Canal Boat Holiday Facts & Figures

- 1. There are over 35,000 canal boats on our inland waterways, more than at the time of the Industrial Revolution, and each year the canal boat hire industry is worth over £33million to the national economy
- Drifters Waterway Holidays is made up of nine hire boat companies ABC Boat Hire, Anglo Welsh, Black Prince, Countrywide Cruisers, Foxhangers, Kate Boats, Napton Narrowboats, Shire Cruisers and Union Canal Carriers
- 3. There are around 1,000 holiday hire boats in the UK and Drifters members, who operate 550 of those boats
- 4. The popularity of narrowboating has been fuelled by the waterways renaissance which has swept across the UK in the last 20 years, with over 220 new miles of waterways re-opened and over £1.5billion invested
- 5. Around 352,000 people go canal boating each year in the UK (*Source: British Marine's 'Watersports Participation Report 2017'*) and around 100,000 holiday boat trips are taken each year.
- 6. There are over 4,000 miles of navigable canals and rivers to explore in Britain, 2,000 run by the Canal & River Trust
- 7. Celebrity canal boaters include Kiera Knightley, Harrison Ford, Timothy Spall, David Suchet, Timothy West, Prunella Scales and John Sargeant
- 8. Recent research by the Canal & River Trust shows that spending time by the waterways can make people happier and improve their life satisfaction (Source: 'Assessing the wellbeing impacts of waterways usage in England and Wales', Canal & River Trust 2018)
- 9. Drifters offers hire boats from 45 bases across England, Scotland and Wales, with day boat hire offered from 18 boat yards
- 10. The main hire boat Season runs from March to October, narrowboats range from 32ft to 70ft and can accommodate up to 12 people
- 11. 2020 short break prices start at £535 on a boat for four people, and £740 for a week
